

GUIDELINES TO BE FOLLOWED DURING ON CAMPUS EXAMINATIONS

Scheduled from 26.10.2020 – 15.11.2020 under COVID 19 Pandemic

CONDITIONS

1. All Candidates, Supervisors, Invigilators and all the others who assist should follow the health guidelines which the government has imposed
2. Temperature will be checked at the main entrance (Police Post)
3. Please use the Hand wash at the entrance (Police Post)
4. Sanitize your palms before entering the Exam Hall (Sanitizer bottle has been placed at the entrances to each examination hall)
5. Examination halls will be opened 15 minutes before the commencement of the examination and every such hall will be sanitized daily
6. Admission cards can be collected at the entrance to the main examination hall (Dhamma Building) on the first day of your examination
7. 20 candidates will be accommodated in a single hall
8. Chief Examiner, Supervisor, Invigilators will be assisted by Hall attendants and a staff deployed by the examinations Dept.
9. Cafeteria will be kept opened. All students are strictly advised to keep distances among themselves when taking food/tea etc.
10. As soon as the examination is over, student must leave Campus immediately
11. Candidates who will have intervals, between papers to be answered, could find seating facility in the new academic building but ensure to keep distance and should not disturb those who would be sitting for respective papers in the other building.
12. Those hostellers who are sitting examinations will not be permitted to go out of the premises during examination period and are advised to bring their linen, provisions and other requirements when they arrive for occupation
13. Any important matter that need to be discussed, please meet Mr. Ranil Meethiyagoda / Director who will act as the Chief Examiner.
